



Matsu-ga-Iso, Transforming with the Tides

The scenery at Matsu-ga-Iso vacillates with the ebb and flow of the tides, connected to the land at low tide, then transforming into an island floating in the sea at high tide. Take in the views of the Pacific, where distant islands give this distinctly Shikoku scenery depth, then head to Mollusco Mugi, a shell museum where you can see shells and fossils from around the world.




