55 Mitsu no Watashi, a Ferry Sailing Through the City Streets

Experience the quaint panorama views of this leisurely, unchanging port from aboard a boat. Mitsu no Watashi is a municipal ferry that connects the 80 meters between Minatoyama and Mitsu, the port area of Matsuyama, as part of Takahama City Route No. 2. Beloved by locals as a means of transportation, this boat has also been gaining attention as a tourist attraction. Reflected in this scenery is Minato Mishima Daimyo Jinja, a shrine that protects this route and offers views of the boats as they sail by.
