19 Views of Hiwasa Seen from Yakuo-ji Temple

Yakuo-ji Temple, the 23rd temple along the Shikoku 88 Temple Pilgrimage, offers views of Hiwasa, a temple town that has flourished since antiquity and retains its old townscape of narrow alleyways called *awae*. From the promenade overlooking the temple town you can see the main temple of Yakuo-ji and a town woven with streets so narrow cars cannot pass. Go a bit further to take in views of Ohama Beach, famous as a sea turtle spawning ground.




