# Frigid Ice Sculpture of Shirai-no-taki Falls

known as an outing place (spot) writers and artists like Shiki Masaoka and Soseki Natsume, 96-meter high Shirai-no-taki Falls reveals different sides of itself throughout the seasons. The most exceptional among these is its winter landscape, when the waterfall freezes and transforms into a fantastic sculpture of ice. Listen to the sounds of the river as you stroll along the walkway from the parking lot toward the waterfall, where you'll be astonished by the sheer size of these falls. At the observation deck, you can take a seat on one of the benches and watch these powerful falls up close.
